Out of this **39 seats kept pending** for the candidates of 2004 PSC exam ,subjected to final verdict of Honorable Supreme Court. Expected final verdict on 7th August 2009. Case postponed to 16th November 2009.Postponed to 27 November. Again postponed to next month.

Insurance Medical officer : 5 vacancy

100 Panchayats in Kerala constructed building for homeo dispensaries and will be sanctioned soon this year. This is under active consideration of finance department. Govt. of Kerala.
If it is sanctioned - 100 more candidates will also get appointment from this list.

Kerala Govt. will start another 200 homeo dispensaries soon under AYUSH scheme - But the appointment is probably by walk in interview and not from this list.

Ratio of appointment

As per special rule 5:1:1:1

5 candidates from rank list : 1 nurse : 1 pharmacist : 1 clerk : in each 8 appointment

This time no Nurses in list, so ratio will be 6:1:1

So in each unit (20) : 4 will be appointed by transfer

But only one clerk included in the current list by transfer

So **after the 7th appointment** - the ratio will be 7:1 - so **in each 8 appointments 7 will be from list** (merit + reservation) and one by transfer from the list of pharmacist.
