A. Professor (in Homoeopathy subjects)

QUALIFICATION

a) Essential : Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy with two years of teaching experience as Reader or a Degree in Homoeopathy with six years of teaching experience as Reader or Diploma in Homoeopathy of not less than four year duration with ten years teaching experience in the subject concern in a Homoeopathic College:

a) Essential: Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy with two years of teaching experience as Reader in the concerned subject or a Degree in Homoeopathy with six years of teaching experience as Reader in the concerned subject or a Diploma in Homoeopathy of not less than four years duration with ten years of teaching experience in the subject concerned in a Homoeopathy College.

The qualification laid down shall be the one included in the second schedule of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act ,1973 (Act 59 of 1973)

(b) Desirable:

- (i) Experience as Supervisor or Guide for Post Graduate Programme in Homoeopathy or Original Publication in research
- (ii) Administrative experience or research experience in a research Institution under the Department of Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy of State Government or Central Government in responsible position

(i) Post Graduate Medical Degree in the concerned subject recognized by Medical Council of India

(ii) Five years teaching experience as Reader or thirteen years teaching experience in the subject concerned in a Degree level recognized Homoeopathic College

(b) Desirable

- i. Administrative Experience or Research experience in a research institution under the State Government or Central Government in a responsible position
- ii. Qualification included in the third Schedule of Homoeopathy Central Council Act. 1973

Age: : Not more than 45 years on the last date of application for the post. Age is relaxable for exceptionally qualified persons

(a) Essential

Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy with four years of teaching experience as Lecturer in the concerned subject in Homoeopathic College or a Degree in Homoeopathy with ten years of teaching experience as Lecturer in concerned subject or a Diploma in Homoeopathy of not less than four years duration with fifteen years teaching experience in the concerned subject in a Homoeopathic College

The qualification shall be the one included in the second schedule of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act ,1973 (Act 59 of 1973)

(b) Desirable :

- i) Experience as Supervisor or Co-Supervisor or guide or Co-Guide for Post Graduate Programme in Homoeopathy
- ii) Administrative experience or Research experience in a research Institution under Department of Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy of State Government or Central Government in a responsible position

Age: : Not more than 40 years on the last date of application for the post. Age is relaxable for exceptionally qualified persons

B) Reader (in Allied Medical Subject)

Post Graduate qualification in Homoeopathy with four years of teaching experience as Lecturer in the concerned subject in Homoeopathic College or a Degree in Homoeopathy with ten years of teaching experience as Lecturer in concerned subject or a Diploma in Homoeopathy of not less than four years duration with fifteen years teaching experience in the concerned subject in a Homoeopathic College

The qualification shall be the one included in the second schedule of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act ,1973(Act No. 59 of 1973)

(b) Desirable :

- Experience as Supervisor or Co-Supervisor or Guide or Co-Guide for Post Graduate Programme in Homoeopathy
- ii) Administrative experience or Research experience in a research Institution under Department of Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy of State Government or Central Government in a responsible position

All Original testimonials should be brought by the candidates for verification during interview.
3. One applicant may apply only for one post only
4. Selection will be made on the basis of marks scored by the candidates out of 100 marks out of which 90 marks allotted for academic qualification and experience, publication etc and 10 marks for interview.
5. No T.A /D.A shall be paid for attending the interview.
